Zero Tolerance Referee Policy

| Introduction | MBA recognizes that development of game officials is essential to aid the continued provision of well organised and well officiated competitions. MBA is committed to provide a safe environment free from harassment and bullying for all basketball participants. This Zero Tolerance Policy has been developed to provide referees with the opportunity to develop their skills in an environment that supports learning and teaches respect. This policy is aimed at eliminating any inappropriate or abusive behaviour from team personnel towards referees during all competitions, leagues and tournaments. |
| | Participating teams will be informed of this policy. |
| Application | Any team member, coach, assistant coach, manager or any person in the team bench area who: *continually questions or challenges referee decisions *abuses or verbally harasses referees * displays inappropriate conduct ,eg, facial or hand gestures and/or overt expressions of anger or dismay, will be subject to the Zero Tolerance Policy. |
| Warning | In some cases the referee will issue a verbal warning first. It should be noted however, that this is solely at the discretion of the referee and that the referee may consider that a Technical Foul should be called without a warning. |
| Technical Foul | Where the abusive behaviour continues or where the referee considers it appropriate, a technical foul will be called. A technical foul on the bench, including anyone in the team bench area, will be called against the coach. |
| Disqualification | Players or coaches that have been issued with 2 technical fouls will be asked to leave the stadium. A player or coach who is asked to leave must do so immediately. If referee needs to make a report, the player, coach, supporter has two days right of reply and a decision on consequences will be made by a sub-committee before the next competition game. |
| Consequences | Any person disqualified from a game will have an automatic 1 game suspension. Failure to leave the stadium on disqualification, or playing whilst suspended will result in the disqualified person's team forfeiting the game in question. |
| Spectators | This policy will also apply to anyone in the upstairs area. If they are a team member they will still be considered part of the team. If not a team member, stadium staff will be asked to remove them and if necessary they may be banned from the stadium complex. Coaches should ensure that anyone in their team bench area follows this policy. Coaches may ask anyone that is not part of their team to leave the stadium arena. |
